At Monarch we are proud to offer your dancer so much more than just dancing. We aim to increase technical ability in as many disciplines as possible, whilst supporting and growing their love and respect for dance, their teachers, their team and themselves. Every class is designed to build self-confidence and selfawareness which leads to creative and heartfelt expression when performing.

The Monarch Company is a family and we take care of our own. We view every dancer as an individual struggling with his or her own challenges and embarking on a personal journey. To us as teachers, it is incredibly important to guide our dancers along that journey, helping them reach personal goals whilst lending a steady hand for those inevitable rough patches. MINIS + JUNIORS

- Minis Dancers age 5 7 & Juniors age 8 10 are usually invited to perform in 1 2 Group
- Dancers MUST take at least 1 Ballet Class in addition to 1 Technique Class per discipline that they are competing in. For instance: If Maisy is in a Junior Jazz Group, she will also take a Junior Jazz Tech Class, and a Ballet Class. If she is also in an Acro Group, Maisy will need to take a weekly Acro Tech class too. This is to ensure that Maisy has great technique, and her choreography class time can be spent working on a winning routine! • Occasionally Juniors are considered for Solos, Duets & Trios. Offers for these positions are
 - discussed with parents when we feel that a student might be displaying talent in a particular area, and dedication to dance. These students must continue dancing in the core • Should you as a parent feel your dancer would like/benefit from further tuition, do not

INTERMEDIATES (INTERS) 10 - 12

- Our Intermediate Dancers are invited to compete in 1-4 group routines
- They will be considered for solos, duos or trios once they have committed to at least 2

SENIORS 12+

- Our Senior Company Dancers display strong technique, stage presence, and charisma which can only be achieved through dedicated, uninterrupted training in the studio. • Dancers MUST take a minimum of 2 Ballet Classes per week, which can be in the form
- of a Group or Private Ballet Class or a Choreography Class • Senior Dancers are expected to compete in at least 3 Competitive Groups and will also

PRE-PRO'5 16 - 18

- Our Pre-Professional Program welcomes our most advanced students and is aimed at dancers who would like to enter the industry as either a professional dancer, a dance teacher, a choreographer or a business owner in the dance/performing arts industry. In addition to dance classes we offer dedicated, exclusive workshops focussing on teaching
- methods, choreography and business principles and ethics. Our Pre-Pro dancers MUST take a minimum of 2 Ballet Classes per week, which can be in
- the form of a Group or Private Ballet Class or a Choreography Class They are expected to compete in at least 3 Competitive Groups.
- Both National and International competitive opportunities will be offered. They will be encouraged to enter for titles and to perform multiple solos.

Our Company Parents have options where tuition is concerned. We strive to make our programs as accessible as possible whilst offering the highest quality dance training in the United Kingdom.


We accept many forms of payment including, Debit and Credit Card We also accept Cheque and BACS.

Based on fee schedule from 2021/2022 Entry Fees are invoiced separately from your termly invoice. Monarch Studios marks up entry fees by 2 - 5% to cover administration, teacher/coach expense, travel, and accommodation. Our teachers are paid to attend all events with your dancers.



WHAT IS EXPECTED OF A COMPETITIVE COMPANY DANCER?

You are a representative of Monarch Studios at all times, be that in class or at Competitions and Events, especially in public. Your behaviour should always be professional. We expect you to be respectful to your parents, your teachers, and fellow students and have a positive, hard-working attitude.

The commitment to the Competitive Season is an entire school year (three 11 or 12 week terms plus 4/5 compulsory competitions). As laid out in the section regarding what we cover in a year, it is clear students are needed for all three terms. **Please consider this carefully when committing to the program. It is a commitment, but it is fun and our Company Dancers can't wait to come to the studio!**

One class absence in a 11-week term is allowed. If this is necessary, please inform us well in advance by emailing or sending a text message. Absences not only disrupt the flow of class and choreography but place your dancer under pressure to make up lost time and may require a private lesson to do so. Exceptions will be made for Covid related absences.

Absences from Competitions and Conventions are not permitted for groups, duets, trios, and quartets. These performances rely on team work and absences will necessitate choreography amendments which requires extra rehearsals. The end result is additional costs to parents for the extra studio / teacher time.

Furthermore, it upsets the existing group's readiness and polish which could negatively affect results. We are BIG on attendance, as this means our students are prepared, confident and achieve great results in their competitions!

Students should arrive 5-10 minutes early for every class and make their way from one class to the next as quickly as possible.

Monarch uniform items are easily obtained and should be worn for all classes in any combination of your choice. More on uniforms ahead...

UNIFORMS + COSTUMES

All Dancers:

Team Jacket - £40 Black trousers for travelling to and from events - Purchase anywhere externally

Minis, Juniors & Inters:

Black, White or Pink Mona by Monarch Leotard (Must be worn for all Ballet Classes) - £25 Suntan Tights - £8

Seniors & Pre-Pros:

Any black leotard (mandatory for ballet classes) - Purchase Anywhere Pink Ballet Tights (mandatory for ballet classes) - Purchase Anywhere Ballet Shoes/Pointe Shoes - 4Dance Ltd. Walton-on-Thames or West Byfleet Suntan Tights - Optional £8

Boys:

Boys can wear a Monarch T-Shirt or a black vest or black leotard and black shorts or leggings.

*Costumes range from £35-£100 per routine. We always try to keep costs as low as possible and reuse costumes a lot! Soloists should talk to their choreographer for costume ideas.

For classes and competitions hair should be in a low bun, parting in the CENTRE with no hair falling in the dancer's face. Use hairspray! Boys should be clean cut and tidy.

For Ballet Competitions hair is usually in a Ballet Bun. We will send a video of our Hair and Make-Up workshop for parents in the Autumn Term so don't worry!

Make Up - Standard stage make up with RED lipstick for girls. *Note to self - watch the video!* Monarch Studios provides all dancers with expert dance training and a positive learning experience. Our structured rules and policies will result in a positive and successful competitive dance education experience. This outline has been created to clearly explain all expectations that are put forth for all dancers and parents involved in this program.

Dancers, Congratulations on being selected to be a part of our competition program! Be proud of your accomplishments. Always stay committed to your classes, dance full-out, and pay attention to your teachers. Those who listen to every correction and apply themselves in every class and rehearsals shall succeed. Remember to show respect to all faculty members, your parents, and all students at the studio. We are all in this together.

Communication amongst the studio and parents shall be conducted via email and each group will have a WhatsApp Group for last minute reminders before/during competitions. WhatsApp Groups are not meant for complaints or concerns. Please email us@monarchstudios.co.uk directly to speak with management or schedule a meeting. Please be sure to check your email regularly for information and any updates. If you do not have access to email, please be sure to inform the studio. A: Mandatory Components

- The Competition season will run from September through July. Parents and students are expected to give a 100% Dance commitment during this time. More than 3 unexcused absences in any competition or required class during our season will result in termination. Exceptions will be made for Covid related absences.

- Last minute withdrawals from any competition are not permitted because each dancer in each routine is important and plays a crucial role in the success of their team. Serious injuries, family tragedies, and Covid isolations are the only exceptions. All entry fees are non-refundable due to each competition's policies.

- Level placement, music selection, choreography, costuming and spacing of all group routines are at the choreographer's discretion. These decisions are made from many years of teaching experience. All staff members are passionate about our competition program. We take pride in every student and every dance routine. We are devoted to providing an excellent experience to all dancers involved. All decisions are made in the best interests of all the dancers.

B: Attendance Policy: Proper attendance is an essential component of the dancer's education and progress. All classes are dedicated to technique and/or choreography. A dancer who misses class or rehearsal may hold back the progress of the entire team. When a dancer is absent from a choreography class, they are expected to learn the choreography prior to returning to the next class. All dancers are allowed no more than 3 unexcused absences Sept through July. Although dancers are allowed 3 absences, we encourage perfect attendance. Dancers should only be absent if it is absolutely necessary. Attendance will be monitored closely in all classes. If your dancer misses a choreography class, they may need a private lesson to learn the choreography.

MONARCH COMPETITIVE COMPANY RULES CONTINUED:

C: Dress Codes

- This policy MUST be followed by all Competitive Company members.

Dancers: You are a role model and it is your job to represent your studio and set a good example for others. Please do not come to dance class in anything other than the set dance attire.

- All pictures and videography of students in classes, at competitions, at performances, or at any studio related event may be used for marketing purposes. If you would prefer your dancer's photos NOT to be used please email jennifer@monarchstudios.co.uk.

D: Conduct Policy

- Respect your teachers and fellow teammates.
- Respect your parents so your dance privileges remain in tact.
- Take care of your bodies and minds by getting good sleep, keeping hydrated and eating healthy foods, especially before classes and performances.
- Maintain a diligent focus on your school work to maintain excellent grades and reports.
- Do not post anything inappropriate on social media remain a positive role model to others.
- Always try your best!
- Strive towards applying a growth mindset in your approach to your dance training. Embrace that failure is a part of success.
- Never forget to see dance as a privilege
- Have fun!

Should my dancer practice at home?

Yes, if possible, please rehearse choreography before coming to the studio so your dancer feels prepared to carry on learning. The harder they work at home and in the studio, the better they'll be on the stage! Good practice makes perfect!

I would like my dancer to have a solo, is this possible?

Yes! If you would like to schedule private lessons, please email us. We encourage our dancers to be in the studio as much as possible!

Can my dancer train and compete at other dance schools too?

Dancers are permitted to tech train at other dance schools as long as trining doesn't interfere with Monarch Studios classes. We encourage our advanced dancers to participate in workshops and associate programs. Dancers cannot **replace** Monarch Tech or Ballet Training with external training.

Is VAT included in your fees? Do you accept Child Care Vouchers? How can I make this more affordable?

Monarch Studios is a Limited Company and we have to charge 20% VAT on all class tuition. We do not accept Child Care Vouchers at this time. We offer flexible payment plans for our families - you can pay for each term in three instalments. To do this, we request your card details so that direct debit can be set up securely on your account. We also offer needs based and talent based scholarships and FREE Enrichment classes for selected dancers to help with progress and finances. Finally, we typically offer a FREE Competitive Company week of training at the studio during or before the holiday periods. Families can also take advantage of our multiple class discounts - Up to 15% off your entire tuition invoice for taking 5 or more weekly classes per term.
